Old alluvium mainly composed of gravel and silica intermixed with clayey layers.

Grape variety:

100% Malbec

Age of the grapevine:

Planted in 1986

Tillage:

Total suppression of weeding.

Working the soil under the vine stock with intercep and on one inter-row in two (discs, claws, subsoiler) and cereals sowing in the other row.

Cultural practices:

Double Guyot pruning system with disbudding of one in two buds.

Manuel thinning.

Manuel leaf removal.

Green harvesting.

Sustainable control.

Harvesting:

Mechanical

Vinification:

Maceration with cold pre-fermentation treatment

Alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel tanks

Malolactic fermentation in wine vats.

Wine maturation:

18 months

50% in French oak barrels



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
